There is a heavenly arithmetic to Christian contentment: subtraction and addition.

First, the subtraction... A famous sculptor once was asked how he could turn a lifeless block of stone into a horse that seemed so vibrantly alive. He answered, "I choose a block of marble, and then carve away everything that doesn't look like a horse."... The journey I took as a new Christian with one text of Scripture helps illustrate this mentality. The text is Psalm 37:4,

"Delight yourself in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart." When I read this, it became a treasured verse that I believed to mean, "If I love Jesus he will give me anything I want." After a while, I grew into a more mature outlook. This verse morphed subtly into this: "Take delight in the LORD, and he will assign me what I should want." Then, finally, it became, "Take delight in Christ, and he will become your heart's desire." And he will satisfy it more richly than we can ask or think.
