You are the love song we'll sing forever, bowing before You, blessing Your name.

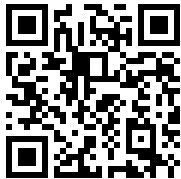

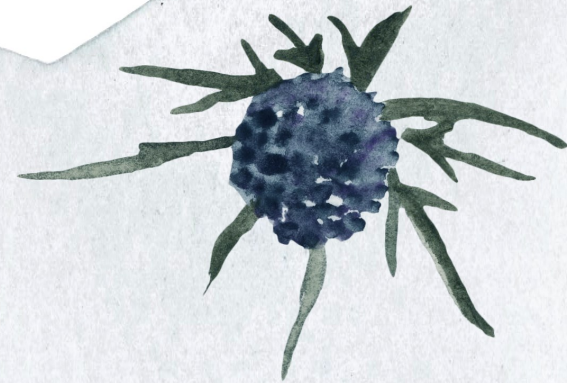
