Ever Thy glorious face to behold, Jesus, I come to Thee.

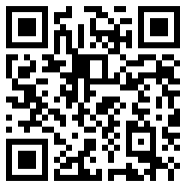

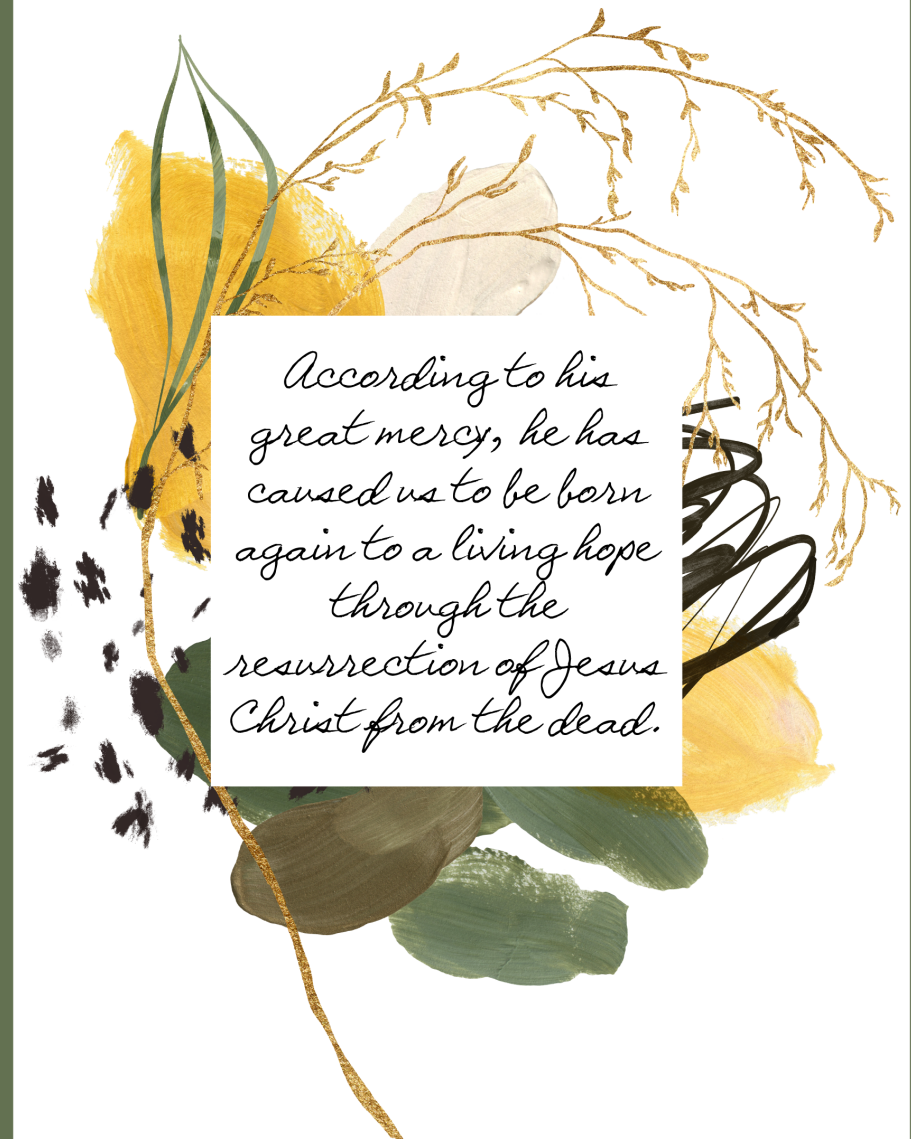
